

CONNECT (BUILD RELATIONSHIPS)

- 1. Do you have any special Easter traditions? Explain.
- 2. If you had to explain Easter to someone with no biblical understanding whatsoever, how would you do it?
- 3. As we end this journey considering the footprints of Jesus, what is one thing you will remember?

THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

- 4. Read Luke 24:1-12. What do you think the women expected to find upon arrival at the tomb? Describe what they might be thinking and feeling. What would you have felt if you were one of those women?
- 5. Luke tells us that the women were "perplexed" (verse 4). A more literal translation might be "astounded, at a complete loss for words." These women had no words to describe what they were feeling, and we get the sense that they were confused. Has anything you've learned or discovered about your faith left you perplexed and at a loss for words? If so, what was it?
- 6. The two men call the women to remember what Jesus told them while he was still in Galilee. Have you ever had to be reminded that you needed to remember something about the faith you were taught before? What was it? What do you wish you had an easier time remembering about our faith?

- 7. In verse 11, Luke tells us that the disciples thought the women's report was an "idle tale." Why did they respond that way?
- 8. Between the two sets of characters in this story, the women and the disciples, to which one do you most closely relate?

COMMIT (BE ON MISSION)

- 9. How might God want to apply the lessons in this text to your life this Easter?
- 10. What difference does a resurrected King Jesus make in your life today?
- 11. Who is someone you are journeying beside who you could pray for that your footprints will leave a lasting impression in their lives?
