- 2. Share about a time when something interesting or amazing happened in a church setting where you think or were told that a spiritual gift was being used.
- 3. Who was your role model growing up? What was it about them that made you want to be like them? How did you succeed in following their example?

# THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

- 4. What specific action does Jesus do in the following verses?
  - John 13:1-5 then verses 13-15.
  - Matthew 8:1-3
  - · John 9:1-6
  - Matthew 21:12

Considering Jesus' actions, is this what he meant when he said we are to follow his example? To what degree should we hold up Jesus as our example?

- 5. Read Philippians 2:5-11. What do these verses tell us about the extent of Jesus' humanity while He was among us?
- 6. Read Ephesians 1:13-14 and Acts 1:8. When and why is the Holy Spirit given to us?

- 7. Read John 5:18-30. In what ways does this passage show you Jesus, fully man and maintaining his decision not to act in his own power/authority, but speaking under the power/authority of the Father and the Holy Spirit?
- 8. Read 1 Corinthians 12:7-14. We can look to verse 7 to find the ultimate purpose of Spiritual gifts, what is it? How does the rest of this passage backup the idea that various gifts are given for a central reason?

# **COMMIT** (BE ON MISSION)

- 9. How does the fact that Jesus relied on his Father's permission and the Spirit's empowerment throughout his ministry affect your understanding of him as your example or model?
- 10. Does the fact that Jesus was God make a difference in treating him seriously as an example? What makes it possible for us to actually follow in Jesus' steps as our model?
- 11. What spiritual practices or spiritual disciplines do you think were a regular part of Jesus' life?
- 12. What ways are you seeking to follow Jesus as your model?
