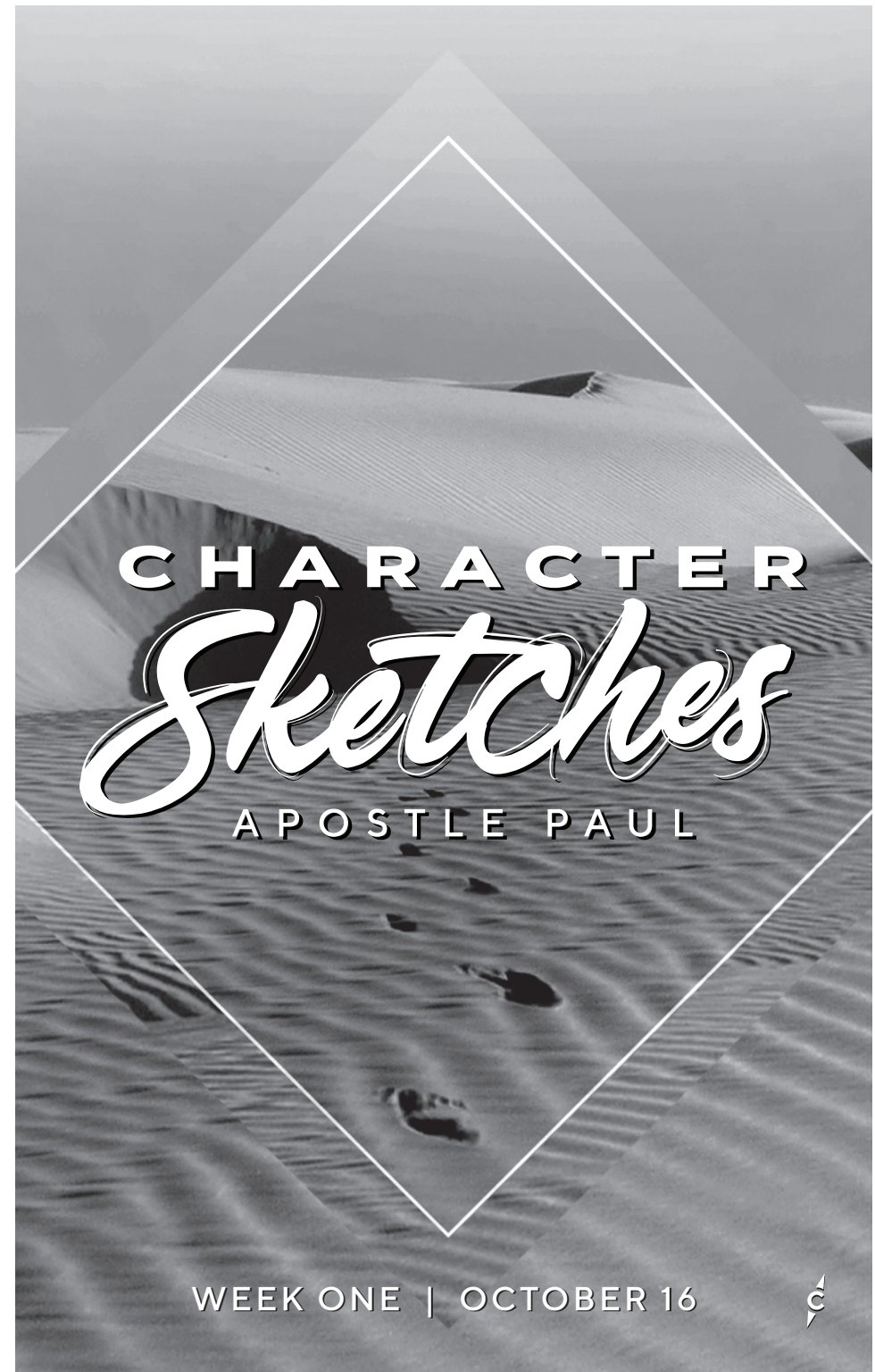

CONNECT (BUILD RELATIONSHIPS)

1. If you could ask Paul one question, what would it be?
2. Who is the least likely person you know who has become a Christian or seemed the most unlikely? Why did you think that it would never happen?
3. The Apostle Paul's conversion experience was on the Damascus Road. What did your road to Jesus look like and how did he meet you there?

THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

4. Read Acts 9:1-9. Why was Saul travelling to Damascus and what was he trying to achieve?
5. What emotions do you think Saul would have felt as he encountered Jesus along the road?
6. What do Jesus's words in verses 5-7 tell us about Jesus' relationship with his followers?

7. Read Acts 9:10-19. Who do you identify with more in this story so far, Saul or Ananias? What do you think this experience would have been like for both men?
8. What do the Lord's words in vs. 15 tell us about his plans for Saul and how might they have been perceived among those that heard them?

COMMIT (BE ON MISSION)

9. What can verses 17-19 teach us about the transformational work of Jesus in a life?
10. Are there any negative qualities or situations in your life God might turn around and use for his glory currently?
11. What encouragement can you take from this study regarding something God is calling you to do?
12. Who is someone you know who seems the most unlikely to place their faith in Jesus that you could pray for?
