WEEK 1 Ecclesiastes 1:1–18

CONNECT (BUILD RELATIONSHIPS)

- 1. What are a few things in your life that bring you the most meaning? What is it about them that is so meaningful?
- 2. What are some things that our culture tells us to pursue to find meaning?
- 3. Why do you think the search for meaning is so important to people?

THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

- 4. Read Ecclesiastes 1:1-18. The theme of the book is summarized in verse 2. What is it?
- 5. What do you think might cause someone to begin a book this way?
- 6. What do you feel Solomon's question in verse 3 is asking, and why do you think he uses the term "under the sun"?

- 7. Solomon emphasizes life is meaningless by stressing the repetition found in nature. Look at verses 1:4-7 and point out the illustrations that he uses. How do these illustrations from nature prove his point?
- 8. Verses 10-11 speak about the emptiness of memories. How is what he says true? How is what he says not true?
- 9. Read Ephesians 2:10 and share how that verse from another perspective addresses meaning in life.

COMMIT (BE ON MISSION)

- 10. Solomon has written a powerful introduction that challenges our core life perspectives. Share how you respond to what Solomon has said in verses 1:1-11. Do you agree or react against it? Why?
- 11. How would you explain the meaningfulness of life to someone who was seeking answers?
- 12. Are there any areas in your life today where you can't see any meaning in?
