

- 1. What is the most memorable road trip that you have ever taken?
- 2. Have you ever felt the calling of God to go to a specific place, talk to a specific person, or do a specific thing? Explain.
- 3. Is there a people group culturally, or possibly a country that you feel a special spiritual burden for?

THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

- 4. Read Acts 9:10-15. Put yourself in Ananias' shoes and describe the emotions you would feel based on this directive from God.
- 5. Read Acts 9:19-22. How was God already using Paul's giftings and experiences?
- 6. Read Acts 9:23-25. What stands out to you regarding the transformation that must have taken place in Paul's heart based on the reactions of others.

- 7. Read Acts 9:26-31. What can we learn about the importance of relationships and partnerships when it comes to the work of the gospel in these verses?
- 8. We read in Galatians 1:17 that after his conversion Paul went to the wilderness in Arabia for three years before beginning his ministry. Read Galatians 1:11-12. What do you think God was doing in Paul's life over that time, and have you ever had a "waiting time" in your life before being released into something you believed God was calling you to?

COMMIT (BE ON MISSION)

- 9. What gifts or experiences from your past might God want to use for the unique things he has called you to do?
- 10. If you could describe your own personal "mission field" right now, where would it be and with whom?
- 11. What excites you about this mission and what makes you hesitant to fully engage? Pray for courage and the power of the Holy Spirit to fill your heart that you might step into everything that God is calling you to.
