

- 5. What do you think washing someone's feet meant in the context of the first century Hebrew world? Who would perform this task and why?
- 6. What do you think was the most shocking thing to the disciples about what Jesus was doing?

- 7. In verse 12, Jesus asks the question, "Do you understand what I have done for you?" If you were in the room, how might you have answered that question?
- 8. What do you think Jesus meant in verses 16-17?
- 9. Read Philippians 2:5-11 and discuss how this passage relates to John 13:16-17.

- 10. Have you ever experienced the washing that comes from Jesus in some way in your own life? Explain.
- 11. What are some cultural barriers that can blind us to the service of others and how might we overcome them?
- 12. Those who are served by Jesus should be transformed to serve others. What is one concrete way you can do this?
