- 2. What is one area in your life where you are a "leader", and one area where you are a "follower"?
- 3. Have you ever had the opportunity to have a leader in your life that you really enjoyed following? Explain.

THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

- 4. Read 1 Peter 5:1. What things in this verse might bring insight into the kind of leader Peter was?
- 5. In verse 2 of chapter 5, Peter uses the comparison of a "shepherd" in describing an elder of the church. What similarities might a shepherd and an elder have in their roles?
- 6. Peter talks about leading "not because you must, but because you are willing". Why do you think he makes that distinction?

- 7. Read verse 3. Peter uses the context of elders in a church, but what are some common things Christian leaders can exemplify in any context to be positive examples to those that are following them?
- 8. In verses 5-6 Peter urges both leaders and followers to pursue humility. What are the benefits of humility and the dangers of pride that you see in these verses? His character and love? If so, share with your group.
