CONNECT (BUILD RELATIONSHIPS)

1. When you meet someone for the first time, what is the first thing you usually tell them about yourself?
2. If we were to ask your 5th grade teacher to describe you using only one word, what word would they use?
3. Take turns, as a group or family, using one positive word to describe each member.

THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

4. Read 1 Peter 2:4-10 and 1 Corinthians 15:45. In what ways are we like “living stones?”
5. Read Romans 12:1-2, Ephesians 5:1-2, Hebrews 13:15-16, and Philippians 1:20. How would you describe a spiritual sacrifice in your own words?
6. What do you think Peter means in verse 9 of chapter 2 when he describes believers as a “royal priesthood”?
7. In what way did and does the stone (Christ) cause some people to stumble and fall?

COMMIT (BE ON MISSION)

8. How should the descriptions of believers in Christ listed in 1 Peter 2:4-11 change how we think about ourselves and each other?
9. 1 Peter 2:10 reminds us that we are people who have ‘received mercy.’ Who is a person in your life that you could extend mercy to this week and how?
10. Remind someone this week that they are God’s special possession.
